

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **Kingsholm Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Kingsholm Church of England Primary School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 5. parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 head teacher
 - 3 foundation governors
 - 3 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors **14**
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with St. Catharine's Parochial Church Council, Gloucester.
7. a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:

The principal officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parish of St. Catharine's, Gloucester.

 - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23(2) of the Regulations.

8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio governor and to appoint a substitute governor.
9. Kingsholm Church of England Primary School has a Christian foundation which it seeks to promote by providing high quality education for all its pupils.

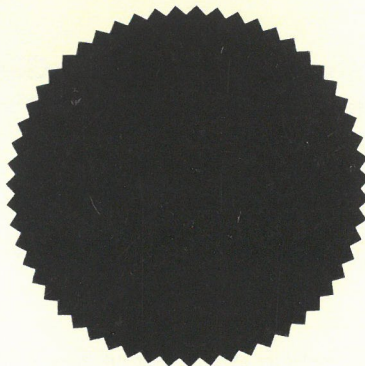
It promotes an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and seeks to encourage high standards and values through the quality of experience which it provides for all its pupils and the example it sets them.
